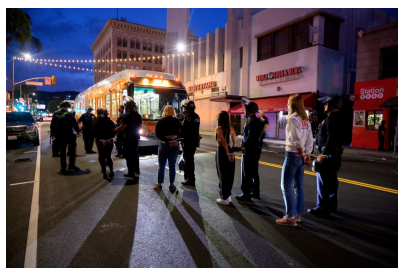


Transportation Consultant Michael Williams Outlines The History And Benefits Of Edge Lane Roads
