LA-based CicLAvia Looks to Create More Open Space in Car-Centric City

Every Sunday from 7am to 2pm, the Colombian capital of Bogotá restricts car travel on nearly 80 miles of city streets, opening them up to cyclists and pedestrians in a city-sponsored event known as Ciclovia, or 'bikeway' in Spanish. The event, which has gone on since the 1970s, draws an estimated 1.7 million participants per week.





Autonomous shuttles will replace monorail system in Jacksonville, Florida

The Jacksonville Transportation Authority plans to install 10 miles of automated shuttle service, in part by repurposing a 33-year-old monorail system, and potentially build transit-oriented development around stations in the expanded system for the north Florida city.

US DOT Will Double the Nation's Electric Bus Fleet (But It Will Still Be Tiny)

A pair of newly expanded federal programs will nearly double the number of electric buses on U.S. roads in one grant cycle alone — if domestic manufacturers can keep up with the demand. On Tuesday, the Federal Transit Administration announced a record \$2.2 billion in competitive grants under the Buses and Bus Facilities and the Low- and No-Emissions Vehicle Programs, which collectively received a staggering 600-percent boost when the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law was signed.

Perspective: Taking Industry Action on AB 5

In June, the U.S. Supreme Court declined to hear the California Trucking Association's case against Assembly Bill 5, which affects driver classification. Absent Supreme Court consideration of the case, the state of California may proceed with implementing AB 5, which reclassifies independent drivers as motor carrier employees.
