

2023 IAME Conference Call for Abstracts and Papers

The METRANS Transportation Consortium at the University of Southern California (USC) and California State University Long Beach would like to invite you to share your research and expertise on maritime economics and policy at the IAME conference to be held on September 5 - 8, 2023 in Long Beach, California. This year we welcome papers or abstracts; there will be a single review process for all submissions.

Conference theme

Important dates

- Deadline for abstract or paper submission: March 31, 2023
- Notification of acceptance and feedback to authors: May 31, 2023
- Deadline for full paper revised version submission: July 14, 2023

Instructions for abstracts:

Submit an abstract of 500 - 1000 words. Describe purpose of the research, Provide a short summary of the existing literature and the expected contribution of this research. Describe methodology and data, and present any preliminary results. Discuss expected results and conclusions to be presented at the conference. Include up to three key words. References are included in the word count.

Instructions for papers:

Submit a paper of up to 7000 words, not including tables or figures. Describe the purpose of the research and place your research in the context of the literature. Describe data and methodology and present research results. Discuss research and policy implications.

Journal publications

As is the tradition for IAME, we encourage submission of papers that may be considered for publication in international academic journals in the maritime, logistics, and transportation sectors such as Maritime Policy and Management (MPM) and Maritime Economics and Logistics (MEL). Individuals (Researchers) who wish to propose a special issue journal must seek approval from the respective journal editor and notify the 2023 organizing committee.

Paper awards

Paper authors should note whether they wish their paper to be considered for a conference paper award.

Abstract Modification or Withdrawal

- Authors may further edit and modify the submitted paper or abstract until the submission deadline. Once acceptance is notified, no alterations to the content will be permitted.
- If you want to withdraw a paper or abstract already submitted after the submission deadline, please notify us as quickly as possible at iame2023@usc.edu. Include the title and reference number of the paper or abstract to be withdrawn. Note that withdrawal is still possible after the submission deadline.

Agreement

By submitting the full paper or the extended abstract, authors agree to the following terms:

- All accepted abstracts will be published in the form of an IAME 2023 USB drive or other.
- Accepted papers will be published in the form of an IAME 2023 USB drive or other with permission of author(s)
- The presenting authors must attend the IAME Conference 2023.

- The corresponding author must sign up for the system with the representative email and submit the abstract or paper. All review feedback will be forwarded to the corresponding author's email.
